Purpose of Position

This internship will equip an administratively gifted person in the areas of church assimilation and follow up, data tracking and input, project management, and other vital areas of church management and leadership. We believe you will leave this internship with a better understanding of how to manage a church campus and lead yourself and others.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Taking notes in meetings and disbursing to appropriate people and leaders
- Helping with monthly and weekly data input
- Creates basecamps for project management
- Follow up with incoming connect cards and making sure the people behind the cards do not get "lost in the system"
- Assisting in the administration of Journey, sending invitations, preparing paperwork and ordering food
- Follow up with Journey connect cards by sending people through to the proper channels/ departments

- Participate in weekly GR team meeting
- Monthly one on one meetings with GR Campus Coordinator
- Occasional meetings with Campus Pastor
- Become familiar with the **Engedi Brand Guide**
- Participate in weekly staff prayer times (every Monday at 1:15pm)
- Participate in Monday staff meetings (monthly)
- Participate in monthly department meetings
- Participate in weekly spiritual formation class on Wednesday mornings
- Participate in weekly leadership class on Monday evenings
- Complete study materials including books, blogs, podcasts, etc as assigned
- Attend weekly worship gatherings, belong to a CABLE group, serve as a volunteer, give financially to the ministry of Engedi
