Purpose of Position

This internship will help with practical applications to ministry (serving, administering, weekly meetings, operating musical software, growing in music theory, leading volunteer teams, etc.) along with spiritually training people how to hear the voice of God. This internship will help people learn how to lead worship, lead a team, and most importantly learn how to lead themselves.

- Occasional meetings with Worship Pastor
- Participate in weekly staff prayer times (every Monday at 1:15pm)
- Participate in Monday staff meetings (monthly)
- Participate in monthly department meetings
- Participate in weekly spiritual formation class on Wednesday mornings
- Participate in weekly leadership class on Monday evenings
- Complete study materials including books, blogs, podcasts, etc as assigned
- Attend weekly worship gatherings, belong to a CABLE group, serve as a volunteer, give financially to the ministry of Engedi
