Position Description

Purpose of Position

The Curriculum Coordinator Intern will have an integral part of the kids team, assisting with editing, implementing, and evaluating curriculum for kids ages birth-5th grade at all Engedi campuses. This individual works closely with the Kids Pastor to ensure that curriculum is consistent among campuses, and that families are supported by providing a strong foundation of faith to set each child on the path to a lifelong relationship with Christ.

Skills and Qualifications

- Ability to carry out the vision of the ministry
- Has good organization skills and pays close attention to detail
- Is able to work on multiple tasks, and is flexible and hard working
- Pursuing degree in and/or equivalent work experience in Ministry or Education preferred but not required
- A positive attitude and willingness to take direction in a fast-paced environment

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Work closely with Engedi Kids staff to:
 - Plan, edit/rewrite all aspects of curriculum to meet the vision and goals of the ministry
 - Creatively plan and implement curriculum that ensures each lesson points to the story of redemption through Jesus
 - Collaborate with kids staff to train leaders and implement curriculum

- Assess effectiveness of curriculum with annual objectives including feedback and observation
- Prepare and organize all curriculum components, including lesson plans, supplies, media and props
- Research cutting edge curriculum ideas, trends and innovations
- Assist in recruiting, scheduling and investing in mid week volunteer team

Other Expectations

- Participate in weekly staff prayer times (every Monday at 1:15p)
- Participate in Monday staff meetings (monthly)
- Participate in monthly department meetings
- Participate in weekly spiritual formation class on Wednesday mornings
- Participate in weekly leadership class on Monday evenings
- Complete study materials including books, blogs, podcasts, etc as assigned
- Attend weekly worship gatherings, belong to a CABLE group, serve as a volunteer, give financially to the ministry of Engedi
