Position Description (Updated July 2023)

Purpose of Position

The Engedi Local Missional Life Intern is responsible for assisting in the planning and execution of Local Missional Life strategies and programs. You will exercise your organizational and leadership skills as you assist in developing ideas, coordinating efforts with local partner organizations, communicating with LML volunteers, and driving ministry initiatives forward. Joining our team will give you the opportunity to deepen your knowledge and experience in local missions.

Skills and Qualifications

- A deeply committed follower of Jesus
- Regularly attends Engedi or is willing to during the period of this internship
- Affirms Engedi's core beliefs, mission, values, and life practices by word and example
- Strong communication and writing skills
- Team player humble, willing to defer to others, supportive of other Engedi ministries
- Self-starter with a professional demeanor and solid work ethic
- Ability (or desire to learn how) to recruit, develop and communicate with volunteers
- Have a heart for showing compassion to the marginalized and vulnerable in our community
- A positive attitude and willingness to take direction in a fast-paced environment
- Excellent time management skills to ensure assignments are completed on time and with high quality

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Assist with all aspects of coordinating large scale Local Missional Life initiatives, including City Serve and Tread.
- Assist the Local Missional Life team in accomplishing department goals with a strong sense of mission, a sense of humor and infectious enthusiasm

- Be an enthusiastic problem solver who loves tackling challenges, accomplishing goals and crushing deadlines
- Assist LML staff in meeting tangible needs in the community through our monthly food distribution called Gleaners
- Manage LML social media by developing a schedule and content for LML social media
- Lead the development and implementation of one strategic initiative or ministry launch

Other Expectations

- Participate in weekly staff prayer times (every Monday at 1:15p)
- Participate in Monday staff meetings (monthly)
- Participate in weekly department meetings
- Participate in weekly spiritual formation class on Wednesday mornings
- Participate in weekly leadership class on Monday evenings
- Complete study materials including books, blogs, podcasts, etc as assigned
- Attend weekly worship gatherings, belong to a CABLE group, serve as a volunteer, give financially to the ministry of Engedi.
