### *Position Description*

*(Updated July 2023)*

### Purpose of Position

The vision of why we want an internship in the worship arts ministry, is to equip people into the calling of God in their lives. This internship will help with practical applications to ministry (serving, administering, weekly meetings, operating musical software, growing in music theory, leading volunteer teams, etc.) along with spiritually training people how to hear the voice of God. This internship will help people learn how to lead worship, lead a team, but most importantly learn how to lead themselves.

### Skills and Qualifications

- A deeply committed follower of Jesus
- Regularly attends Engedi or is willing to during the period of this internship
- Affirms Engedi's core beliefs, mission, values, and life practices by word and example
- Effective administrative skills including the ability to set goals, facilitate advance planning, and effectively manage schedules
- Strong communication and writing skills
- Team player - humble, willing to defer to others, supportive of other Engedi ministries
- Self-starter with a professional demeanor and solid work ethic
- Ability (or desire to learn how) to recruit, develop and communicate with volunteers

### Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Serve in the offices (to a certain capacity) throughout the week
- Play an instrument
- Go through Journey
- Come to rehearsals prepared musically, and also prepared to run rehearsals
- Reflecting our core values
- Serve at least two Sundays a month

## Other Expectations

- Participate in weekly staff prayer times (every Monday at 1:15pm)
- Participate in Monday staff meetings (monthly)
- Participate in monthly department meetings
- Participate in weekly spiritual formation class on Wednesday mornings
- Participate in weekly leadership class on Monday evenings
- Complete study materials including books, blogs, podcasts, etc as assigned
- Attend weekly worship gatherings, belong to a CABLE group, serve as a volunteer, give financially to the ministry of Engedi
